We expect children to spend between 2-3 hours on their homework project over several days or weeks.

All items should be brought in the day before(31/03) the open afternoon as we do not have space in class to store them all. PLEASE DO NOT SEND IT IN ANY EARLIER.

At the end of term, we would like the children to have their completed work in school on the afternoon of **Friday 1**st **April** for the exhibition.
